Acting 101

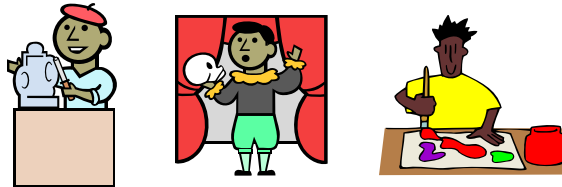
